Invites received accepted or declined

- Invitation to Cor Persain on October 18th. Unfortunately, I am unable to attend. Deputy Mayor asked to attend representing ATC
- Task Force meeting attended on September 17th
- Attended Consultation Placemaking Plan on 23/9/25 in the Pensioners Hall. Attendance has been reported as very good

Additional information

- Ammanford Extravaganza was a success. Thank-you to everyone involved
- Ammanford Food Market appears to be going from strength to strength
- Work in Ammanford Park
 1. Additional seating has been installed within the play area in Ammanford park
 2. Benches within main Ammanford park have been repaired and restored
 3. Unsafe exercise equipment removed plans underway to replace with (Covid funded) picnic tables from the Arcade.
 4. Flower bed in front of tennis courts are being worked on currently. Bedding wall was unsafe therefore, plans to rebuild have been approved and replanting following years of neglect

Correspondence with Regen team and CCC

- Railings and gates repainting project discussions being held with Regen team. Quotes have been provided
- Iscennen roundabout discussions held with CCC to “make good”. ATC will then plant and maintain
- Bus bay bed discussions held to “make good”. ATC will then plant and maintain
- Tirydail junction bed discussions have been held for its removal with CCC
- Bed (behind toilets in main Ammanford car park) discussion with CCC to “make good”. ATC will then maintain
- Cleaning of French flag this will be undertaken shortly
- Previous Sofia Nails building Regen have contacted Planning control and are awaiting an update
- Following full council approval 12-18mths ago, the Interim Clerk is costing flags to be erected across town centre. The flags will be Welsh and ATC flags. Although, additional requests will be considered. These will be erected at the same time as work is being carried out for the Christmas lights
- Ammanford Post Office has been issued with an Enforcement order due to its poor state of Repair
- The Refreshing Town Centre Fund has been publicised widely within the town however, no applications have been received

We continue to work closely with the Regen team and I am delighted to announce that we have had £30,000 approved for our Christmas lighting.

Once again can I thank you for your continued support.
